50 Ways to Help Re-Elect Governor Gregoire before Election Day.

At a Local Field Office:

1. Find your nearest field office at www.ChrisGregoire.com and **volunteer**
 2. Help canvass
 3. Help make phone calls
 4. Help staff an office
 5. Help with mailings
 6. Help enter data
 7. Help recruit volunteers
 8. Help ID voters
9. Help crowd build for Governor Gregoire's events
10. Help organize/plan events for Chris in your community
 11. Bring a friend to a Team Gregoire Field Office
 12. Make food for other volunteers
13. Drop by a field office and help with their wish list

In the Community:

14. Attend an event in your neighborhood
15. Wear a Gregoire button/sticker in public places
16. Put a Gregoire bumper sticker on your car
17. Place a Gregoire yard sign in your yard
18. Attend a fundraiser near you
19. Register voters at a community event
20. Recruit volunteers at meetings of clubs or groups that you are a member of or are in your area
 21. Get involved with your local Legislative District Democratic group
22. Volunteer to help recruit and raise awareness for the governor at events in your neighborhood
 23. Contact your neighbors and discuss the election with them
24. Walk your neighborhood for a local field office, knocking on doors of undecided voters
 25. Support your local Democratic candidates
26. Bring weather gear for volunteer canvassers when it starts to rain

Election Day:

27. Join Team Gregoire for sign waving on Election Day
28. Help get people to the polls to vote, by reminding them or driving them
29. Help elderly/disabled people vote
30. Be a poll monitor

In General, at Home, or with your Friends:

31. In the **168 hours** you have every week, please spend **one** of them helping Chris
32. In the **1200 hours** until the polls close, please contribute at least seven to ensuring that we keep Washington blue for another four years.
33. Educate yourself about the issues- don't let other people tell you what's going on
34. Talk to your friends about your beliefs in Governor Gregoire, discuss the issues that matter to them
35. Remember why you want to see Chris Gregoire elected- have your own reasons
36. Help keep the record straight- don't let people distort the Governor's record
37. Be friends with Chris on FaceBook/Myspace
38. Use social networking web pages to show your support/create groups of supporters to notify them when volunteer opportunities arise
39. Blog about the issues
40. Email your address book and explain why it's important...
41. Watch the debates
42. Host a house party
43. Host a debate watching party ("Dinner and Debate")
44. Register three of your friends to vote
45. Call your family members and make sure they know why it's important that Governor Gregoire be re-elected
46. Make your own signs and put them up/Have a "Sign-Making Party"
47. Write a Letter to the Editor of a local newspaper, talking about the issues that are important to you
48. Find a friend who is a Rossi supporter and convince them otherwise (may take more than seven hours)
